Lesson 4: Prospering the Mind, part 2 [2 December 2018]

I. Strengthen the Mind

- A. 1 Peter 1:13-20
- B. Verse 13: "gird up the loins of your mind"
 - 1. (1Pe 1:13) [Amplified Classic Version] So brace up your minds; be sober (circumspect, morally alert); set your hope wholly *and* unchangeably on the grace (divine favor) that is coming to you when Jesus Christ (the Messiah) is revealed.
 - 2. (1Pe 1:13) [New Living Testament] So prepare your minds for action and exercise self-control. Put all your hope in the gracious salvation that will come to you when Jesus Christ is revealed to the world.

(1Pe 1:13) [Message Translation] So roll up your sleeves, put your mind in gear, be totally ready to receive the gift that's coming when Jesus arrives.

- Gird = build strength through repetition
- Gird = to refresh
- Loins = the seat of procreative power
- a. The Mind is the Battle Ground where we triumph over Evil
- b. Win the battle of the mind & you will conduct yourself as a Christian
- c. John 8:31-32

II. Conforming Our Will to God's Will

- A. We must know God's Will: Colossians 1:9
- B. It's going to take a change in Mindset
 - 1. Ephesians 6:14
 - 2. 3 John 3-4
 - a. It please God when we, the Body of Christ, walk (live every day life) in the Truth of God's Word
 - b. Do so by continually walking in the Truth of God's Word

III. Change the Way You See Yourself

- A. (Pro 23:7) [King James] For as he thinketh in his heart, so is he ...
- B. 2 Corinthians 3:18
 - 1. God's Word is like a mirror
 - 2. What do you see when you look into God's mirror
 - 3. When we look in a mirror we make attempts to change what we see (wash our face, comb our hair), so we will look good to others, as well as ourselves
 - 4. When we look into God's Word we see things that need correction & God's Word tells us how to correct those things
 - 5. To Change (Transform) = reshape the appearance

IV. Transform Your Thinking

 - 2. 1 John 5:4
 - 3. Philippians 4:13
- B. Think ahead, not behind
 - 1. Isaiah 43:18-19
 - 2. (Isa. 43:18) [Amplified Classic Version] Do not [earnestly] remember the former things; neither consider the things of old. (Isa 43:19) Behold, I am doing a new thing! Now it springs forth; do you not perceive and know it and will you not give heed to it? I will even make a way in the wilderness and rivers in the desert.
 - 3. Satan attempts to destroy a life by keeping thoughts of the past in their mind
 - i. Romans 12:10 = he's an accuser of the brethren
- C. Ephesians 2:6 "we've been made to sit with Him"
 - 1. Verse 10: "we are His workmanship"
 - 2. We are forgiven
 - 3. We are accepted
 - 4. We are redeemed
 - 5. We are chosen
 - 6. We are predestined
 - 7. We are BLESSED
