MESSAGE 9: SONS OF THE LIVING GOD
[28 November 2021]

- **Foundational Scripture:**

- Colossians 1:9-10
 - Filled with God's Will: the knowledge of His Will, His Wisdom on how to apply and operate His Will in our Life, with a Spiritual Understanding
 - God's Will in the natural doesn't make sense to a natural mind: "lay hands on the sick", "speak in another tongue", "cast our demons"
 - We chose to Live in the Will of God:
 - Choosing to Live in Love
 - Choosing to Live the Righteous Path
 - Choosing to Live by Faith
 - You are then choosing to be Worthy and Pleasing to God
 - You are choosing to be Fruitful in every good work: this is our Christian Life Goal
- 2 Peter 1:10 = "make your calling and the election of that calling SURE"

I. **Living a Holy Lifestyle**

- a. Colossians 1:22
 - i. Jesus paid the full price for our sins: 2 Corinthians 5:21
 - ii. Jesus became the curse, with our sins, so that we could walk freely in the BLESSING: Galatians 3:13-14
 - iii. Jesus' desire is to present the Believer:
 - 1. Holy = Christlike in character & nature
 - 2. Unblameable = no blame for wrongdoing
 - a. Repentance blots out the sin
 - b. Repentance brings refreshing: a clean start
 - i. Acts 3:19
 - 3. Unreprovable = no evidence of sin
- b. Colossians 1:23
 - i. Faith in God's ability to forgive
 - ii. Faith in Jesus' Blood's ability to cleanse
 - iii. Faith in God's Covenant Words to wash away all spiritual filth

- iv. Holding our Hope (expectation, confidence) in the Gospel of Christ (the yoke destroying, burden destroying, devil destroying Power (The ANOINTING) of God (through His Holy Spirit))
- c. Colossians 1:27-28
 - i. Verse 27: “Christ in you the Hope of Glory”
 - ii. Keep the perspective that it is God’s Holy Spirit working in and through the Believer to do His Will & Good Pleasure
 - 1. Philippians 2:13
 - 2. Every act of Love is beneficial to the person receiving that act: God IS Love – 1 John 4:16

II. Sons of God

- a. 1 John 3:1-2
- b. Romans 8:14-17
 - i. Suffering (from Stong’s Concordance) = to experience the same kind:
 - 1. An experience that is painful: specifically, persecution
 - 2. To experience the same Passion: Jesus Passion was to operate as God desired
 - ii. Hebrews 2:18
 - iii. Hebrews 5:8-9
 - iv. Hebrews 2:10
- c. 1 Peter 5:9-10
 - i. James 4:7 => submit to God FIRST
 - 1. Submission to God’s Plan provides the Power
