

# O LORD, REVIVE YOUR WORKS

## Message 1: Moving Into Position [3 January 2021]

- **Isaiah 40:1-5 = Prophecy is meant to move us into God's position to receive the fullness of that Prophecy.**
- **Isaiah 60:1**

### I. **What Made This Prophet Afraid of God's Words?**

- a. Habakkuk 1:1-4
  - i. Verse 1: SEE = the full scope of what was happening in the natural, physical realm
  - ii. Verse 2: The Prophet is screaming at God to be heard
  - iii. Verse 4: Why am I seeing a lack of judgment (punishment)
- b. The Prophet had Revealed to him what was happening in the natural, physical realm by the people:
  - i. The people were slack where God's laws were concerned
  - ii. That brought lawlessness to the society
  - iii. Good had become evil, and evil had become good in the eyes of the people (sound familiar?)
  - iv. Sound Lawful judgment was not going forth

### II. **God Works Through His Prophets**

- a. The Prophet's Ministry has been abused and misunderstood today and therefore the ANOINTING of that Ministry has been diminished
- b. Amos 3:7, 3
  - i. Verse 3: The Prophet MUST agree with God's Vision
- c. Habakkuk 3:2 = Three things the Prophet is DEMANDING of God:
  - i. Revive Your Work
  - ii. Make Known Your Glory: Habakkuk 2:14
  - iii. Remember Your Mercy

### III. **Prophetic Words to Oasis of Life Ministries:**

- a. The Word of God to the Pastor or Prophet is a Word to the Whole Church
- b. Patricia Abdalla at a Prayer Meeting: 3 June 2016
  - i. "God's Power to heal is hidden in Pastor Jerry's hands"
  - ii. Habakkuk 3:5
- c. Gary Wood at Oasis of Life: August 2014
  - i. "It is turnaround time" "It is all open to you NOW!"
  - ii. An Apostle of God is able to operate in all of the ANOINTINGS of Ministry

- d. Gary Wood at Oasis of Life: October 2015
  - i. “You are My Voice over this Region”
- e. Gary Wood at Oasis of Life: October 2016
  - i. “Pastor Jerry, you’re taking a new seat of Authority; increase and overflow is here. Get into position for notable Miracles to be happening here.”
- f. Kenneth E Hagin’s Prophecy, April 28, 1983 – in part \*
  - Get up in faith and tell what great things He’s going to do.
  - And He’ll move and keep His Word with you! And many shall be astonished. But the greatest miracle of all is that there’ll be so many fish caught in the net that the nets can’t hold them. There won’t be church houses enough to hold the people. Amen, Amen.
  - For the purpose of it all is that you may be fishers of men. Hallelujah! Quit fishing, Hallelujah! Quit fishing in your bathtub. There’s not any fish in your own bathtub. Go out where the fishes are and throw out the net. Not the hook, the NET! And pull it in. hallelujah. And bring them in.
  - And the glory of the Lord shall shine. And the end time shall come. And you’ll stand in the place, yes many of you that stand here including myself, will stand in the place of ministry that you’ve not stood in before. And will stand in the place that’s been ordained for you from the foundation of the earth! Hallelujah. Hallelujah.

Moving into that place is fueled by prayer, fired by the Spirit and ignited with His Glory. Hallelujah to Jesus. Glory to God. I said, “Glory to God.” Glory to God. Glory to God. Hallelujah. Hallelujah, praise God.

But you see if there’s no fuel there, there’s nothing to ignite. Notice the Spirit said [I never thought of that, it came out of the inside of me] fueled by prayer, fired by the Spirit, ignited with His Glory. You have to stop and analyze that., there’s a difference between firing, igniting – yes.

You see it’s like the furnace, you see? There’s a pilot light there that fires the thing. And then when the whole thing has become ignited then the heat flows out. Ha, ha, ha, can you see what He’s saying? Fueled by prayer, fired by the Spirit, ignited with His Glory. Hallelujah. I never thought of that. I mean it just flowed up out of my spirit. But you see if there’s no fuel there, there’s nothing to fire. If there’s no fuel, there’s nothing to fire. Fueled by prayer. Hallelujah, hallelujah.

#### IV. Listen, Obey, Write, Read, and Run

- a. The Prophet was called to Overcome the Lawlessness in the Land
- b. Run to take action to the Vision (what is your vision?)
- c. What is your Vision for your home, your life, your family, your Country, your Church?
- d. Habakkuk 2:1-4
  - i. Verse 1: Reproved = God proving to the Prophet what needs to be spoken (confessed, professed) in order to overcome the Lawlessness
    1. Reproved = God's opening arguments, as a Lawyer, in a court case
  - ii. Verse 2: Vision = (Pro 29:18) [Amplified Classic Version] Where there is no vision [*no redemptive revelation of God*], the people perish; but he who keeps the law [*of God, which includes that of man*]*—blessed (happy, fortunate, and enviable) is he.*
  - iii. Verse 4: a soul lifted up = swelled, filled with pride
    1. Pride says I don't need God's Laws or justice
    2. Pride says nobody, including God, tells me how to live
    3. "THE JUST SHALL LIVE BY HIS FAITH"  
*Question:* Is it our denominational faith that we're operating in? Or is it God's Faith, from His Covenant Words, that is developed in us?
