- **Foundational Scripture:**

- (Eph 2:8) [*Amplified Classic Version*] For it is by free grace (God's unmerited favor) that you are saved (delivered from judgment *and* made partakers of Christ's salvation) through [*your*] faith. And this [*salvation*] is not of yourselves [*of your own doing, it came not through your own striving*], but it is the gift of God;

#### I. **Revive Thy Works: Habakkuk 3:2**

- a. John 14:5-14
  - i. Verse 12: as believers we all should be doing His works
    - 1. Doing them by the same ANOINTING Christ operated in
    - 2. Matthew 9:35
    - 3. Luke 4:18-19 (from Isaiah 61:1-4)
  - ii. Isaiah 60:1-3 & Isaiah 61:1-4
    - 1. Jesus was assigned 5 works: the number of Grace
    - 2. The Church is assigned 7 works: the number of completion
    - 3. Isaiah 61:1-2; Jesus is introducing God's Grace
    - 4. Isaiah 61:2-3; the Church is to complete the Work
      - a. Verse 3: Hebrews 1:9
      - b. Verse 4: a summary of the Works

## II. **Jesus IS What We Declare Him to Be to Us**

- a. God, The Father, The Son, and The Holy Ghost will be to you what you declare them to be!
- b. 2 Corinthians 4:13-18
  - i. Verse 15: ALL THINGS! All what things?
    - 1. Verse 1: Ministry
    - 2. Verse 4: The Gospel of Christ [THE ANOINTING]
    - 3. Verse 5: Preaching [sent & inspired by God]
    - 4. Verse 6: Revelation Knowledge
    - 5. Verse 6: The Glory of God
  - ii. All God's Grace to the Church
    - 1. Redound = excel, to lift or take to the Glory of God
  - iii. Verse 16: the Cause = Get us to the Glory
  - iv. Verse 17 = verses 8 & 9
  - v. Verse 18: natural things are "subject to change"
    - 1. As we do verse 13
    - 2. James 1:22 = hear with an intent to do
- c. The Bottom Line = 2 Corinthians 5:7
