## **Versions of Scriptures:**

(Hebrews 1:8) [*Amplified Classic Version*] But as to the Son, He says to Him, Your throne, O God, is forever and ever (to the ages of the ages), and the scepter of Your kingdom is a scepter of absolute righteousness (of justice and straightforwardness).

(Hebrews 1:9) [*Amplified Classic Version*] You have loved righteousness [*You have delighted in integrity, virtue, and uprightness in purpose, thought, and action*] and You have hated lawlessness (injustice and iniquity). Therefore God, [*even*] Your God (Godhead), has anointed You with the oil of exultant joy *and* gladness above *and* beyond Your companions.

(Hebrews 1:8) [*New Living Translation*] But to the Son he says, “Your throne, O God, endures forever and ever. You rule with a scepter of justice.

(Hebrews 1:9) [*New Living Translation*] You love justice and hate evil. Therefore, O God, your God has anointed you, pouring out the oil of joy on you more than on anyone else.”

(Hebrews 1:8) [*Message Bible*] But he says to the Son, You're God, and on the throne for good; your rule makes everything right.

(Hebrews 1:9) [*Message Bible*] You love it when things are right; you hate it when things are wrong. That is why God, your God, poured fragrant oil on your head, Marking you out as king, far above your dear companions.
