Message 5: BREAKING THE YOKES & CHAINS

Foundational Scriptures:
Joel 2:11

I. The Fast that I [God] have Chosen

- a. We're in the time of the fullness of the Holy Spirit: Pentecost
- b. Isaiah 58:6-12
 - i. Verse 6: Fast = to cover the mouth, protect what goes in and what goes out
 - ii. (Isa 58:8) [Amplified Classic Version] Then shall your light break forth like the morning, and your healing (your restoration and the power of a new life) shall spring forth speedily; your righteousness (your rightness, your justice, and your right relationship with God) shall go before you [*conducting you to peace and prosperity*], and the glory of the Lord shall be your rear guard.
 - iii. (Isa 58:8) [Message Bible] Do this and the lights will turn on, and your lives will turn around at once. Your righteousness will pave your way. The GOD of glory will secure your passage.
 - iv. Verse 11: our Water will never FAIL [lie or deceive]
 1. John 4:14 = wells spring of Water [the New Birth]
 2. John 7:38 = River of Living Water [The Baptism of the Holy Spirit]
 3. 2 Corinthians 6:16-18

II. Operating in the Standard of the Holy Spirit

- a. Isaiah 59:1-2, 16-19
 - i. Verse 16: Jesus is the Intercessor God Sent
 - ii. Verse 19: the Standard
 1. (Isa 59:19) [Amplified Classic Version] So [*as the result of the Messiah's intervention*] they shall [*reverently*] fear the name of the Lord from the west, and His glory from the rising of the sun. When the enemy shall come in like a flood, the Spirit of the Lord will lift up a standard against him *and* put him to flight [*for He will come like a rushing stream which the breath of the Lord drives*].
 2. The Standard:
 - a. Jesus Christ
 - b. The Holy Spirit
 - c. The Covenant Words of God
 - iii. Verse 19: It's The Christ, the Holy Spirit and the Body of Christ (the Church) working together to bring the FLOOD by the Standards of Christ: THE ANOINTED ONE with HIS ANOINTING
