- FOUNDATION:

- 1 Peter 1:1-5, 18-23
 - There is NO Sanctification without Revelation
 - There is NO Revelation without an understanding of the Integrity of God's Word
 - John 17:16-19
 - As you acquire the Truth you are separating yourself more and more from the world's system (a system of lack, poverty, sickness, disease, hatred, and greed)
 - God's system (His Kingdom) is BLESSING, ANOINTING, Grace, Mercy, Love, and Righteousness
- (Acts 10:38) [*Amplified Classic Version*] How God anointed and consecrated Jesus of Nazareth with the [Holy] Spirit and with strength and ability and power; how He went about doing good and, in particular, curing all who were harassed and oppressed by [the power of] the devil, for God was with Him.
 - Sanctification: to set apart, set in order
 - Integrity: unbroken state, Truth, Honesty, wholeness

I. The Word of God Separates Us from the Old Sin-natured Man

- a. Ephesians 4:23-24 = this is a continual effort
- b. 1 Peter 1:23 by the incorruptible Seed of God's Word of Truth
 - i. If this works for the new-birth (it does) it works for your healing, finances and relationships

II. The Word of God Separates Us from the World's & its Overload

- a. John 8:32
- b. Romans 6:14

III. The Word of God Separates Us from Unnecessary Things Unto God

- a. Ephesians 5:1-2
 - i. Greek word for “followers” = mimic the speech, accent and manner of life
- b. Romans 8:29
- c. John 14:9
 - i. Does the world & the Church see Jesus through you?
- d. “The new creatures in Christ have been given the God kind of Love with which to care for another and God kind of Faith with which to do something about it” – Kenneth Copeland –
- e. (1Peter 1:2) [*Amplified Classic Version*] Who were chosen and foreknown by God the Father and consecrated (sanctified, made holy) by the Spirit to be obedient to Jesus Christ (the Messiah) and to be sprinkled with [His] blood: May grace (spiritual blessing) and peace be given you in increasing abundance [that spiritual peace to be realized in and through Christ, freedom from fears, agitating passions, and moral conflicts].
 - i. All men are chosen to receive God but all men don’t make that choice
