 - What is Eternal Life?
 - A complete removal from death: spirit, soul, body, relationships & finances
 - When does Eternal Life begin?
 - At the New birth experience
 - Titus 3:5
 - John 10:10
 - Romans 12:1-2
 - Verse 2: TRANSFORMED by the renewing of the mind

I. Our Knowledge of God & God's Covenant Words MUST Grow

- a. Romans 10:17
 - i. A lack of knowledge of God's Covenant Words is the greatest hindrance to faith
 - ii. A lack of hearing & understanding God's Covenant Words – produces a lack of faith
 - iii. Our faith grows as our understanding of the Covenant Words of God grows

II. God has made us ABLE & given us the Legal Right to be Partakers of the Full Inheritance of the Saints of Life: NOW!

- a. 2 Peter 1:3-4
- b. Colossians 1:9-18
- c. As God's Workmanship in Christ, we can fight the good fight of faith
 - i. 1 Timothy 6:12
- d. To fight the good fight of faith we must have a personal revelation of who we are in Christ: Ephesians 2:10
 - i. 2 Corinthians 5:17 means there are no sin scars left on the born-again believer

III. Revelation of Our Identification with Christ

- a. Jesus went to Calvary as our substitute when we were dead in our sins: Ephesians 2:1
- b. Jesus became sin that we might have right-standing with God in Christ: 2 Corinthians 5:21
- c. We were crucified with Christ: Romans 6:6, Galatians 2:20
- d. We were made alive with the same resurrection power that raised Christ: Ephesians 2:2-10
- e. We are NOW seated with Christ, victorious over Satan: Colossians 2:13-15
- f. Receiving Christ's suffering as our substitute we become a new creature in Christ: 2 Corinthians 5:17

IV. In Christ we have Redemption

- a. Hebrews 9:12
- b. Romans 10:9-10 = confession creates realities
 - i. This is MINE
 - ii. This is who I am
 - iii. This is what I have
- c. God's Covenant Word ALWAYS work
- d. **Ephesians 1:6-7 = redemptive rights**
 - i. Galatians 3:13
 - ii. Redeemed FROM Deuteronomy 28:15, 61
- e. Colossians 1:13-14
- f. Put on the whole armor of God: Ephesians 6:10-20
 - i. **By speaking (confessing, professing, testimony) what God's Covenant Words say about you: Hebrews 10:23**
 - ii. Pray God's Covenant Word, Agree with God's Covenant Words & disagree with the situation
