#### AMAZING GRACE MESSAGE 5: SHOUT GRACE TO THE MOUNTAIN [28 JANUARY 2024]

## • FOUNDATION:

- 2 Peter 1:2
- Ephesians 2:8
- 2 Corinthians 9:8

## I. Not by Might, Nor by Power; But by My Spirit (says the Lord).

- a. Zechariah 4:6-7
  - i. Zerubbabel was commissioned to oversee the rebuilding of the Temple in Jerusalem.
  - ii. He needed the Words of God's Prophet to take hold of his position with confidence.

# II. Accessing the Grace of God

- a. Romans 5:2
  - i. We MUST reach into the increasing levels of God's Grace by Faith.
- b. Zechariah 4:7
  - i. Who is this, Mountain?
  - ii. The Obstacle (mountain) for many who would do wonderful things in God's Kingdom is their own sense of inadequacy.
  - iii. When a devoted and willing heart yields to God, the Grace to accomplish God's plan will become more and more evident.
- c. Zechariah 4:6 Then he said to me, "This is what the LORD says to Zerubbabel: It is not by force nor by strength, but by my Spirit, says the LORD of Heaven's Armies.
- d. Zechariah 4:7 [*New Living Translation*] Nothing, not even a mighty mountain, will stand in Zerubbabel's way; it will become a level plain before him! And when Zerubbabel sets the final stone of the Temple in place, the people will shout: 'May God bless it! May God bless it!'"
  - i. The Living Bible: "declaring that all was done by Grace alone."
- e. Joel 3:10 = "let the weak say: I am strong"

# III. <u>Faith in God removes the mountains: Grace keeps the mountains from moving</u> you.

- a. 2 Peter 3:18 = grow in Grace
- b. 2 Peter 1:2 = Grace will be multiplied to us
- c. James 4:6 = God gives more Grace
  - i. We must activate and develop this Grace.
  - ii. To change the environment around us, we must first allow Grace to change us inside (in the heart of man).
- d. W. Tozier: "Truth that is not experienced is no better than error and is just as dangerous."
