✚ FOUNDATION:

- **John 10:10 [Renner Interpretive Version] [2nd part] “But I have specifically come with the express purpose that you will have, hold, and possess a phenomenal and amazing life. My purpose is that you will possess life so full that it overflows and spills over like a mighty river so full of water that its banks can no longer contain it all. I’m talking about an amazingly full, spirited and vivacious life that is literally overflowing and spilling over. I have explicitly come so you can possess an abundant, profuse, plentiful, and bountiful life.”**
- **Ephesians 2:10-13, 19**

I. Faith in the Blood of Jesus

- a. We have been allowed to share in the New Covenant by our Faith in the Blood Jesus Shed
- b. James 2:17-23
 - i. James 2:23 [Weymouth’s New Testament] - and the Scripture was fulfilled which says, “AND ABRAHAM BELIEVED GOD, AND HIS FAITH WAS PLACED TO HIS CREDIT AS RIGHTEOUSNESS,” and he received the name of ‘God’s friend.’
 - ii. James 2:23 [The Passion Translation] - So in this way the Scripture was fulfilled: Because Abraham believed God, his faith was exchanged for God’s righteousness. So he became known as the lover of God!
 - iii. James 2:23 [Message Bible] - The full meaning of “believe” in the Scripture sentence, “Abraham believed God and was set right with God,” includes his action. It’s that mesh of believing and acting that got Abraham named “God’s friend.”

II. To Long Strangers to the Covenants of Promise

- a. Why did Jesus say what He said in John 6:51? (verse 53)
 - i. His flesh & Blood is our Spiritual, Covenant Meal
 - ii. Jesus has given us:
 - 1. His Strength: Ephesians 6:10
 - 2. His Authority: Matthew 28:18-20
 - 3. His Weapons: Ephesians 6:10-18
 - 4. Himself as our Covenant Meal: 1 Corinthians 11:23-32
- b. What is Faith in Jesus Blood?
 - i. Romans 3:25
- c. What is Atoning Blood?
 - i. Atonement = Covering (Old Covenant)
 - ii. Atonement = to make covering (Old Covenant)
 - iii. Romans 5:11 = Reconciliation, a complete change
- d. What is Remitting Blood (Jesus BLOOD)?
 - i. Remission = sending away, to completely wipe out
 - ii. Matthew 26:28
 - 1. Jesus sent our sins to hell & left them there

 - 7. His Side: John 19:34
